

As I remember parking my Astra Estate by the labs as well as company cars that we used to bring the kit from E.port.... and enjoying food in the canteen and staying at a pub/hotel in Moelfre... The last analyser that I worked on was set up right by the lab itself not far from the HBr burner.... I never saw this commissioned but had worked night and day on it.
